


DAY ONE – Friday 18th June




- Arrive in Deer Lake airport to meetup with the group
- Journey begins with a transfer to the town of Corner Brook
- Enjoy a welcome dinner (included) and get acquainted with all your fellow travellers
- Evening free time

DAY TWO – Saturday 19th June



- Enjoy some walks and some leisure time to explore Corner Brook and the area
- Enjoy a 3.7 km morning walk to see the Captain James Cook Historic Site and Monument but it's the panoramic view over the Bay of Corner Brook that's the true gem
- Afternoon options include a walk through the town and the stunning Corner Brook Stream Trail

DAY THREE – Sunday 20th June



- Depart for Gros Morne National Park where we walk and explore the otherworldly Tablelands with exceptional ecology and world-significant geology with an interpreter guiding you through the landscape described as a "geologist's dream"
- Tablelands is one of the few places where the Earth's mantle is revealed.
 Pushed in place as continents collided almost half a billion years ago, its orange weathered rock is from the middle layer of the Earth

DAY FOUR – Monday 21st June



- Cruise the two connecting fjords of scenic Bonne Bay
- This excursion highlights the geological wonders, rich cultural history and the diversity of the fascinating bay with opportunities to view eagles, moose, whales and seabirds in this incredible setting
- Visit Lobster Cove Lighthouse with a short guided walk around 'the Head' to take in some of the most spectacular and picturesque views in Gros Morne National Park
- Stay at the Shallow Bay Motel 2nd night






DAY FIVE – Tuesday 22nd June

DAY SIX – Wednesday 23rd June




- Longer drive of the holiday from St. Antony in the north to Gander in central Newfoundland




DAY NINE – Saturday 26th June

Advice on gear.

Weather is variable with average temperature highs ranging from 16-17 degrees Celsius in June with the exception being St. Anthony in the north with average temperatures of 12. Night time lows are 6-10 degrees lower. There are usually 6 hours of bright sunshine every day of the 16 hours of daylight.

As accustomed walkers you will know how to dress in layers for any weather conditions.

It is strongly recommended that you bring both good hiking boots and light rain gear.

Setting the scene.

Best we be reminded that Newfoundland is often referred to as 'the other Ireland.' There are some films and documentaries that will give you an idea of the surroundings from the film 'Orca' to the documentary 'My Ancestors Were Rogues and Murderers' which I so happen to have in my library for a movie and popcorn night. 'You Are Here: A Come from Away Story' the film that has captured many an audience as a musical play. Many of the Newfoundlanders are of Irish descent, most of which settled in Avalon Peninsula.
